

## ACCESS TO PSYCHOEDUCATIONAL TESTING

Three other ways you may be able to access psycho-educational testing (that do NOT involve going through a research study, the school, or a full-fee private psychologist):

### **Psycho-educational testing done through York University:**

- Call any time of the year to let them know you're interested: [416-650-8488](tel:416-650-8488)
- There is usually a waiting list (apparently 4 months is typical)
- Psycho-ed testing done year-round by Ph.D. students who are supervised by an experienced clinical psychologist
- Fee is on a sliding scale (\$1,800 is their full standard fee for families with no financial struggles; other families pay only a portion of that fee, depending on their means)

### **Psycho-educational testing done through University of Toronto:**

- Call from end of September to mid-December (during any given year, as their testing is ongoing) to leave a message on their intake line indicating you're interested: [416-978-0678](tel:416-978-0678)
- They will call you back in January or later
- Psycho-ed testing done between January and Spring by Ph.D. students who are supervised by an experienced clinical psychologist
- Fee is on a sliding scale (\$1,500 is their full standard fee for families with no financial struggles; other families pay only a portion of that fee, depending on their means)

### **Psycho-educational testing done through Oliver Martin Assessment Scholarship:**

- Scholarship awarded to family in financial need (who have a combined annual income of less than \$75,000) to get psycho-ed testing done for child: <http://idaontario.com/assessment-scholarship.html>
